## Chaperone Responsibilities

### Friday, June 20

7:30 am	Arrive at Oakland airport. Meet in front of the Southwest Counter. Collect the tickets and IDs from your choristers. Once everyone boards, help your choristers get their bags in overhead compartment or under the seat in front of them.
9:30 am	Flight 2285 departs Oakland. Monitor behavior throughout the flight.
12:55 pm	Flight 2285 arrives Denver. Collect baggage. Chartered bus will meet us at the airport. Bus will stop on the way to University of Denver for lunch (\$\$) Help maintain control of kids at restaurant or fast food place. Make sure they clean up after themselves.
3:00 pm	Registration / Check in at the Dormitories. Keep the kids quiet and orderly until everyone is registered. Help them find their rooms and remind them of the rules. Let them know where your room is if you are not in the same room with them. Remind them to stay with their partner at all times.
5:00 – 6:15 pm	Dinner
6:15 – 6:30 pm	Walk the children to the rehearsal hall.
6:30 – 8:30 pm	Rehearsal – Sturm Hall Once the children have gone in, only one chaperone needs to remain. If you leave, make sure to return by 8:30 so you can accompany your children to the ice cream social and back to the dorm.
8:45 – 9:45 pm	Ice Cream Social
11:00 pm	Lights Out. Perform a final room check.

### Saturday, June 21

7:00 – 8:30 am	Breakfast
8:45 am	Gather the choristers together and accompany them to Sturm Hall for rehearsal. Only one parent needs to stay. If you leave, please return by 11:30 to accompany the children to lunch.
9:00 – 11:30 am	Rehearsal – Sturm Hall
11:30–12:45 pm	Lunch.
12:45 pm	Meet your students and walk them to Sturm Hall for their next rehearsal. Only one parent needs to remain for the rehearsal. If you leave, please return at 4:00 to accompany them back to the dorm.
1:00 – 2:00 pm	Concurrent Sectional Rehearsals – Sturm Hall/Towers Lounge
2:30 – 4:00 pm	Rehearsal – Sturm Hall
4:00 pm	Walk the students back to the dorm and help them get ready for the trip to Pirates Cove (swim suits, towels, sandals, sweatshirt or light jacket, long pants.)
4:00 – 4:45 pm	Prepare for Pirates Cove
4:45 – 9:30 pm	Dinner and group activity at Pirates Cove Water Park
11:00 pm	Lights Out. Perform a final room check.

8:15 – 8:30 am	Assemble students for special CCC trip to Denver Mountain Parks. Make sure your charges are on the bus.

11:30 – 1:00 pm	Lunch for those not on the CCC Tour
1:45 pm	Assemble students at 1:45 and walk with them to Newman Center for rehearsal. Only one adult needs to stay.

10:30 pm	Walk students back to the dorms.
10:30 – 11:00 pm	Pack and Lights Out. Encourage children to pack their bags leaving out only what they will wear home (Black Cantabella T-shirt)

### **Tuesday, June 24**

6:30 am	Wake up Call. Make sure bags are packed and rooms cleaned before releasing kids to the dining commons.
7:00 – 7:30 am	Breakfast (short but sweet!)
7:30 – 7:45 am	Load the bus/ depart for airport (\$\$ souvenirs / food at airport) Help the children take their bags downstairs to the bus. Perform a final room check for cleanliness, items that may have been forgotten.
8:00 am	Bus departs for Denver Airport.
8:50 am	Check in at Southwest Airlines. You should have the choristers' airline tickets and ID. Help with crowd control during check in.
10:50 am	Flight 2614 departs Denver
12:25 pm	Flight 2614 arrives in Oakland. Remain with your charges until they have been picked up by their parents.
